



### From Ireland of the 1970's to Ireland in 2023

- o Joined EEC in 1973
- o 1980's: Unemployment and emigration
- From net emigration to immigration in mid 1990's
- Good Friday Agreement, 1998
- International Protection and Direct Provision, 2000
- Establishment of a Ministry for Integration in 2007
- EU Enlargement, freedom of movement increases in immigration 2004 to 2008
- o Temporary Protection Directive (Ukraine), 2022



- Cultural Awareness and Anti-Racism
- Active Community Participation


