

# Free food and basic material support packages will be made available to people in Ukraine

Within the framework of the [Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived \(FEAD\)](#) programme implemented by the Society Integration Foundation, food and basic material support packages are provided to Ukrainian war refugees in Latvia who have received a crisis certificate issued by the municipal social service.

Ukrainian civilians will be eligible for aid under the Operational Programme of the [Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived \(FEAD\)](#), after receiving a crisis certificate from the municipality's social services. For three months, one person can receive two food parcels, a hygiene parcel, a household parcel, two additional baby food parcels for small children aged 7-24 months, and an additional hygiene parcel for families with young children under 2 years of age. In addition, families with primary and upper primary school-age children will receive a school supplies package.

With a certificate, you will be able to receive the aid packages at one of more than 400 distribution points throughout Latvia. People can receive meals prepared in the soup kitchens of the [Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived \(FEAD\)](#) without a certificate or other documents.
